HERE'S HOW TO SET UP A LEGACY MINISTRY PROGRAM AT YOUR CHURCH:

1 Engage Key Church Leaders

As with any new ministry, it is important to have the support of the key leaders in your church, specifically those who serve in its financial ministries on staff or as volunteers. The TBF will assist your church by providing the tools and training for these leaders to understand the impact of a legacy ministry and to equip them to lead the efforts in your congregation.

2 Develop a Legacy Ministry Unique to Your Church

As we all know, each congregation is gifted with unique visions for ministry. Your Legacy Ministry can—and should—be designed to reflect the distinctive passions of your people in reaching the world for Christ. The TBF will consult with and support you as you craft how your Legacy Ministry should be established at your church. This includes developing guidelines and documents for the Ministry as well as identifying the leaders who will oversee it.

3 Communicate the Vision

As you launch the Legacy Ministry in your church, the TBF will work with you in planning how you effectively communicate and implement the vision in your church. On an ongoing basis, the TBF will be there to assist with seminars and information that supports your Legacy Ministry. The TBF also will work with your church in evaluating the ministry and making adjustments to ensure that your Legacy Ministry is effectively expanding the stewardship conversation at your church.
